

## SPRING IN THE PO DELTA PARK IS NATURALLY SLOW!

Until 20th June, there will be an extremely rich programme of events, guided tours and excursions to natural environments

Over five weeks of events immersed in the splendid scenery of the Po Delta Park, including excursions to natural environments, birdwatching experiences, workshops for children, and dozens of events dedicated to photography, food and wine, traditions and culture, and environmental education. This is Primavera Slow, the event dedicated to nature lovers that, following last year's forced stop, will be back until 20th June 2021 hosted in the Po Delta Park, a UNESCO MAB Reserve. An extremely rich programme of initiatives that will involve all the Po Delta Park municipalities: from Rosolina to Goro, from Mesola to Comacchio, from Ravenna to Cervia, and from the coast to the hinterland, discovering the Argenta Valleys, the Bando Oasis, the Ostellato Valleys, and the territories of Lower Romagna area.

There are many ways to enjoy the beauty of the local area! On foot or by boat, by bike or train or even on horseback, riding the magnificent Camargue horses. Enormous environmental wealth is also reflected in the numerous animal and plant species identified within the Po Delta Park: almost 300 species of birds, 50 species of fish, 10 species of amphibians, 15 species of reptiles, 40 species of mammals and more than 1,000 plant species.

There are so many events to jot down in your diary and you will be spoilt for choice: from the most classic, such as cycling trips to the Comacchio or Cervia saltworks, to the most original, such as Bike&Spritz at Mesola Castle or canoeing along the Bevano river. You can spot dozens of birds around the old Goro lighthouse or enjoy a Bike&Boat experience along the Po River; you can

Moreover, for those who wish to combine the charm of nature with that of art, there will be plenty of opportunities to combine the natural beauty of the Po Delta with the enchantment of the culture that distinguishes these territories, discovering the marvels of the buildings, monuments and churches that characterise many of the municipalities in the area.
