A completely flat landscape, **an area that looks like an immense cycle path** where the bicycle is, of course, the perfect tool to fully discover its characteristics. Ecological, sustainable and healthy, the cycling holiday will most likely also be one of the trends of the upcoming summer season.

The landscape of the Po Delta Park is full of different suggestions, where land and water always open up new roads to be pursued: **from Comacchio to Ferrara, from Cervia to Ravenna, along the Destra Po cycle tourism route that horizontally cuts through the Ferrara area or along the banks of the Lamone river from Bagnacavallo to the Adriatic Sea**: hundreds of kilometres overlook a land marked by a network of cycle tourism routes that meander between the city and the countryside, between protected oases and villages on the plain.

Surrounded by enchanting landscapes, **the Po Delta Park offers ideal cycling routes for everyone, perfect for a weekend, but also for excursions and day trips**. The natural environments of the rivers and floodplains, the lagoons, the valleys, the naturalistic oasis of the Po Delta Park, not far from the historical centres such as Ferrara, Ravenna, Mantua, Venice, Comacchio, the villas and the Delizie Estensi, offer many opportunities to visit places of interest.

Short, safe itineraries to cycle comfortably with families, or circular routes ideal to explore the surrounding area; or even long stretches to be spread over several days to better discover the area, exploring it in all its facets. There are dozens of itineraries on offer, aimed at all target groups, to discover amazing journeys through art and nature.

You can, for example, try your hand at an original **"Bike & Spritz" in the Mesola area**, a ring-route that will allow you to get to know the history and nature of several symbolic locations, such as the 16th-century Torre Abate, the Estense Castle with its beautiful courtyard, the mighty banks of the Po di Goro and the Bosco della Fasanara, **in Comacchio, among the various possibilities, a tour of the Salina (Saltworks) is a must**, to discover a treasure chest of history, tradition and biodiversity, with the spectacular flight of pink flamingos, avocets and dozens of other species of avifauna behind it. On the other hand, travelling to the province of Ravenna, to celebrate the 700th anniversary of Dante's death, **a guided trip to the "divine thick and living forest", a source of inspiration for the Supreme Poet** in the writing of the Comedy, is an absolute must. Or you can go as far **as Cervia's salt mountains**, even along a stretch of a new cycle path that will allow you to reach the watchtower and admire a truly unique panorama.
