

THE WONDERS OF THE PO DELTA PARK BETWEEN LAND AND WATER

Land and water, two contrasting yet complementary elements that characterise the entire Po Delta area, the result of an age old history, capable of shaping a changing landscape in which woods, pine forests and flooded forests alternate with inland wetlands of fresh or salt water. Even today, in fact, the Po Delta Park represents a dynamic environment, in continuous evolution, where nature is free to give new land or to take back parts of it.

For lovers of nature and slow tourism, discovering this area by boat is truly priceless. Cervia, Goro, Comacchio, Porto Garibaldi and Savio are only some of the starting points **for evocative boat trips**, to admire some of the most beautiful areas of the Po Delta Park from a truly unusual perspective or to be able to land in certain areas that would not be accessible in any other way.

Along the inland canals of the Comacchio lagoon, to admire the beauty of a spectacular oasis where hundreds of species of aquatic birds live, or to travel back up the Adriatic coast to the Sacca di Goro and towards the river delta; among the impenetrable reed thickets of the mouth of the Po di Volano or immersed in the mirrors of water and the treasures of the Cervia Salt Pan; on the Bevano river, between the Ortazzo and Ortazzino Oases, or directly on the Po Grande while sipping a pleasant aperitif. There are a whole array of possibilities and each and every single one of them has very different characteristics and facets in terms of space, environment, landscape and birdlife. It is therefore difficult to choose which one is the best; it would be better to jot them down in your diary and plan them all!

For the whole summer, for example, from Porto Garibaldi you can set sail to the extraordinary setting of the Comacchio Valleys during sunset to enjoy its marvellous hues. The best way to end a hot summer day on the beach! After coming back from the boat trip, a dinner of freshly-caught fish will be served on board, expertly cooked according to traditional recipes.

While still enveloped in the magical sunset atmosphere, you can go on a trip by electric boat on the Bevano river, between the Ortazzo and Ortazzino Oases, immersed in an almost unspoilt environment. A stop at the watchtower is envisaged, a privileged point from which to admire the landscape and the animal species that populate it, with a view that sweeps from the Classe Pine forests to the sea.

Sports enthusiasts can **also discover the area by canoe**, by going on exciting trips to discover the Cervia Saltworks, along the Bevano river or in the heart of the Comacchio Saltworks.
