Autumn is slow in the Po Delta Park. Until 19th December, **dozens of naturebased excursions** will take place in the picturesque scenery of one of the most important wetlands in the world, which has been recognised as a UNESCO MAB International Biosphere Reserve. In fact, it is in autumn that the Po Delta Park becomes tinged with enchanting colours and the vegetation becomes extremely lush. Therefore, what could be better than a weekend immersed in nature to enjoy all its wonders? **Boat trips, walks, bike rides, guided bird-watching tours and many special initiatives to experience the magic of autumn landscapes** while in pursuit of a territory and its environmental and cultural beauty.

Cycle routes ideal for everyone, perfect for a two-day trip but also for excursions and day trips; walks to savour the silence of nature to discover the valleys and historical routes; trips on board small and large-sized boats, sailing either by sea or through valleys, to enjoy the magic of a land of water and its dreamy landscapes; or even with binoculars hanging around your neck, observing a veritable paradise where wetlands, river branches, age-old woods, pine forests and sand dunes welcome and protect many species of birds, some of which are truly rare! More than 370 species of birds can be spotted, including a rich colony of pink flamingos.

From Argenta to Goro, from Mesola to Comacchio, from Ravenna to Cervia, there are hundreds of excursions to go on in order to experience the uncontaminated nature of these places to be savoured at a slow pace.

Throughout the entire month of October, for example, you can enjoy guided canoe tours on the Bevano river, in one of the most fascinating natural scenarios of the Po Delta Park, or cross the delicate ecosystem of the impenetrable reed thickets of the mouth of the Po di Volano river on board a small boat; you can experience the charm of the flooded forest of Punte Alberete on foot or lose yourself in the autumn colours of the San Vitale pineforest.

In addition to the natural beauty, you can also enjoy the cultural wonders that characterise this area, discovering through guided tours **the masterpieces of the Delizia del Verginese, the Pomposa Abbey or the Churches of Ravenna**, to name but a few. In the capital of mosaics, you can also try your hand at mosaic art in a modern workshop.
